Note 1 - Significant Accounting Policies

Basis of Accounting

The Vermont State College Faculty Federation's policy is to prepare its financial statements on the modified cash basis of accounting; consequently, certain revenues are recognized when received rather than when earned and certain expenses and purchases of assets are recognized when cash is disbursed rather than when the obligation is incurred. Accordingly, the accompanying financial statements are not intended to present financial position and changes in net assets in conformity with generally accepted accounting policies.

Basis of Presentation

Financial statement presentation follows the recommendations of the Financial Accounting Standards Board Accounting Standards Codification (ASC). As required by the Non-Profit Entities topic of the ASC, Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations, the Local is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to two classes of net assets: net assets without donor restrictions and net assets with donor restrictions. As of September 30, 2022, and 2021, the Local did not have net assets with donor restrictions.

Income Tax

The organization is a not-for-profit organization that is exempt from both federal and state income taxes under Section 501 (c) (5) of the Internal Revenue Code.
